The Orange Public Library presents programs that are informational, educational, and recreational to meet the needs and interests of the community. All library-sponsored programs are free and open to the public. However, a donation for materials may be requested from the participant.

No individual or organization presenting a program sponsored by the Library, may sell their products or services. Exempt from this policy are authors and illustrators who come to speak about books they have written or illustrated. All materials to be used or displayed by presenters must be approved by the Library Director, Library Manager, or Librarian-in-Charge.

When promoting programs, the library may refer to the organization or business affiliation of the presenter. This does not constitute endorsement, merely acknowledgement.

The Orange Public Library reserves the right to utilize photographs or video taken at the library for publicity purposes in printed materials and online. All library patrons consent to the use of their photo taken by library staff (or designee) while at the library, or during library events, unless they specifically inform staff of an objection to such use. Names will not be used in conjunction with photos without express written consent.
