ORANGE PUBLIC LIBRARY STEVE AMBRIZ READING ROOM USE

The Steve Ambriz Reading Room at Orange Public Library & History Center is used for Children's Services library programs and programming that is cosponsored by Children's Services.

When the room is not in use for scheduled programs, it will be open for children and their caregivers.

Those who use the Steve Ambriz Reading Room must follow these rules:

- Children age 7 or younger must be accompanied by an adult or caregiver (age 13 or older).
- Adults and teens must be accompanied by a child age 12 or younger.
- Return all library materials that are not checked out to the designated book return cart.
- Be respectful of others, so they may also enjoy the surroundings. This
 includes speaking softly, using the room appropriately, and not disrupting
 others.
- Pick up any play items the child has used.
- Library Rules of Conduct Policy.

During scheduled library programs, the Steve Ambriz Reading Room may be limited to registered participants only.

The room will close 15 minutes prior to the library's closing.
