The Tannas Family Children's Garden at the Orange Public Library & History Center is designed for library programs by Children's Services and its partners. When the Garden is not in use for scheduled programs, it is open to children and their caregiver(s).

The Garden will close at dusk or 30 minutes prior to library closing each day. Staff may close the Garden during inclement weather and periods of maintenance.

While using the Garden, please adhere to the following rules:

- Entry to and from the Children's Courtyard is only permitted from inside the library.
- For safety reasons, children may not be left unattended in the Garden and must be accompanied by their caregiver at all times.
- All adults and teens 13 and up must be accompanied by a child 12 and under to use the Garden.
- All library materials taken outside must be returned inside. Failure to respect and return all library materials may result in fees for damages.
- No running, jumping, climbing, or touching of fountain, plants and statuary.
- The Library's Rules of Conduct Policy applies to the Tannas Family Children's Garden.
